To the Honorable the Judges of Said Court:-

The petition of Ida E. Denton of Frederick County respectfully shews:

- 1st. That Preston S. Denton late of Said County died intestate about the month of August A. D. 1887. Legally and possessed of valuable real estate in Frederick County, described in the proceedings in the above case, and leaving Mollie L. Denton, Mary Ann Denton, Kuldew Denton and Preston S. Denton, all of whom are infants and minors in Frederick County, as his only children and heirs at law.
2. That on the 25th day of November A. D. 1887, Geo. Geo. Buckley as next friend of said infants, and who was also their grand father, filed his Bill of Complaint in the above case praying for a decree for the sale of said real estate for distribution among said heirs at law and said widow and the said Mollie L. Denton as widow, filed her consent in writing agreeing to such sale, all of which will appear by the proceedings in the above case:-
3. That on the 31st day of December 1887, Your Honorable Court passed a decree in said case and appointed Geo. William Buckley, and Milton G. Ames as Trustees, to sell said real estate and who advertised and offered said real estate at public sale but did not sell the same, and the same has since been seised by order of your Honorable Court.
4. That since Preston S. Denton was at the time of his death indebted unto your Petitioner by his notes one of Three Thousand dollars, dated Nov. 3, 1885, payable one year after date with interest from date, and the other for Eighteen Hundred dollars dated April 6, 1886, payable one year after date with interest
