and heirs at law of Mary W. Grayson deceased
under the age of 16 years, and therefore the said
Samuel W. Williams together with A. J. Grayson and
L. J. Grayson his Sureties entered into and acknowledged
a bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars, Conditional
according to law, which said bond is approved by
the Court, and ordered to be recorded, wherein from
said W. Williams, Guardian, took the oath as required
by law.

Samuel W. Williams having heretofore in this Court duly
qualified as the guardian of Mary Kemp Grayson,
Harriet Rosalie Grayson and Lafayette Grayson Jr. infant child-
ren of Mary Kemp since Grayson dead, and executed
bond as such Guardian in the penalty of \$2000 = and
the Court now being advised that it is proper so to do
and the proceedings therefor being had as provided,
by law it is ordered that the said Samuel W. Williams
as such Guardian do execute a new Bond in a
large penalty than said former bond to-wit: - in the
penalty of \$4000 = whereupon the said Samuel W. Williams
