

Copy of Bond.

Know all men by these presents, That we, Samuel W. Williams, A. J. Grayson, and L. F. Grayson each hereby waiving the benefit of our Honorable Exemption as to this obligation, and also waiving any claim, right or privilege to discharge any liability arising under this bond, or by virtue of said or trust in any Currency, funds, Counter Claim or offsets, other than legal tender Currency of the United States, as provided by an act of Assembly of Virginia, approved August 26th 1884, are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the just and full sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars to the payment of which, well and truly to be made to the said Commonwealth we bind ourselves and each of us, and each of our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally; firmly by these presents sealed with our seals, and dated the 3rd day of June one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, and in the 12th year of the Commonwealth.

The Conditions of the above obligation is Such, That if the said Samuel W. Williams, who has qualified in the County Court of Bland County as guardian for Mary Kemp Grayson, Harriet Cecelia Grayson and Lafayette Grayson for infant children of Mary Kemp sine legem deced, shall faithfully discharge the duties of his office or trust as aforesaid, then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
