To the Honorable, the Judges of Said Court:—
The Petition of Samuel W. Williams of Ayler County in the State of Virginia respectfully shews unto your Honors:—

1. That he is the duly appointed Guardian to Mary Kemp Sinn Grayson, Harriet Rosalie Fackler Grayson and Lafayette Grayson, Junior, infants Children of Mary Kemp Sinn Grayson, deceased, by proper Authority in said County in the State of Virginia, where the said infants reside; that he hath given good and sufficient security for the faithful performance of his trust as guardian, and that as guardian he there has the Custody of the persons of said infants.

2. That the entire amount of personal property belonging to said infants, and now subject to his Control as guardian, is no funds in the State of Virginia but the infants are entitled to the proceeds of the sale of their real estate in Frederick, Maryland and now on said State Writ, and the said infants are now each entitled to four hundred and ninety-three dollars and seventy-six Cents, being their distributive shares of the proceeds of the Sale of the real estate of their Mother, Mary Kemp Sinn Grayson deceased, in Frederick Maryland as stated above and ascertained and distributed in the first Auditor's Report filed in the above entitled Cause in your Honorable Court, and which distributive shares are now in the hands of Milton G.
