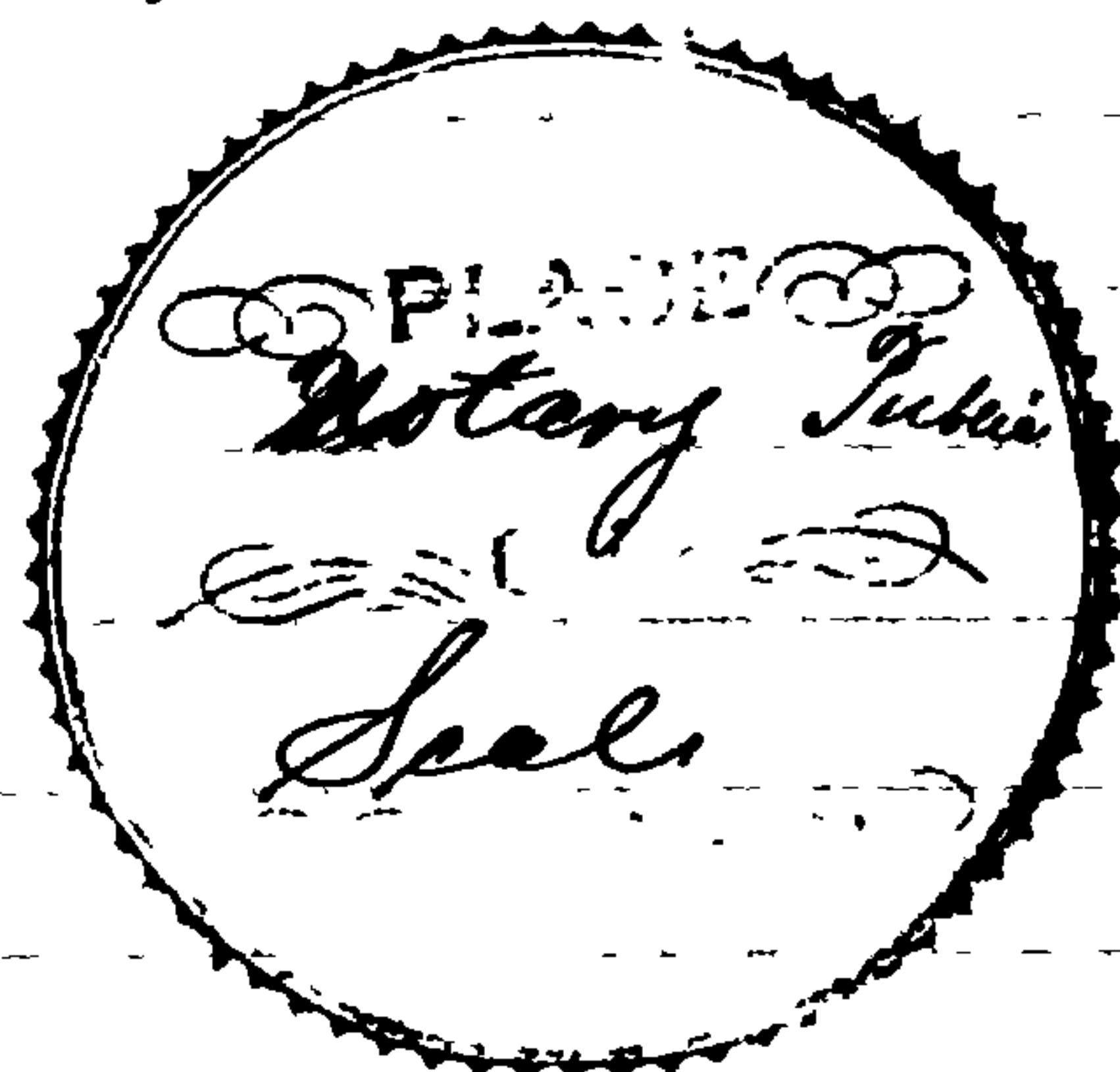
hundred dollars, being their distributive shares of the proceeds of a second sale made by said Trustee in the above cause and to be hereafter accurately ascertained by a further audit.

3. That your Petitioner's authority to act for said infants as guardian ad hoc shall be further appear by a duly authenticated copy of the record of his appointment and qualification as such Guardian, and of the Bonds given by him for the faithful performance of his trust as guardian, with the affidavit of the Chief Clerk of Island County, in the State of Virginia, by whom such security was taken, as to the sufficiency of such security, filed herewith and marked "Exhibit No. 1."

And your Petitioner, therefore, prays your Honorable Court to pass an order authorizing and directing the said Milton G. Hous. Trustee to pay to your Petitioner the amount of the distributive shares of the said infants now in his hands or that may hereafter come into his hands, as ascertained by the audits in the above cause and that your Petitioner may have all such other and further relief to which he may be entitled he will ever pray, &c.
