Petition & Amended Bill.

Filed August 22nd 1895.

To the Honorable, the Judge of Said Court:-

The Petition of William B. Wheeler and William A. Wheeler partners carrying on business as W. B. Wheeler & Son: Plaintiffs in the above entitled Cause in your Honorable Court, respectfully shows unto your Honor that since the filing of said Bill your petitioners have been informed that in addition to the persons mentioned as defendants in said Bill, there are certain nephews of said John Frey, the deceased intestate whose lands are sought to be sold in these proceedings sons of a brother Elias Frey who removed to the far West many years ago, and died there leaving several children, whose names and residences are unknown to your petitioners.

Also that Henry Frey, a deceased brother of said intestate, left surviving him, a daughter Mary Frey who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland but believed to reside in Indiana.

Your Petitioners therefore, pray your Honor for leave to amend said, by making said William Frey son of said Henry Frey deceased, and the unknown heirs of said Elias Frey, deceased, parties defendants to said Bill, and that they be included in the prayer for an order of Publication, against the non-resident defendant contained in said Bill. (Said order not yet having been issued.)
