The object of this Suit is to procure for the sale of the real estate of which John Frey late of Frederick County, Maryland died seized and possessed. The Bill states,

1. That said John Frey being seized and possessed of certain real estate lying and being in Catoctin District in said Frederick County, died intestate in or about the month of June 1890, without leaving any personal property, but leaving surviving him, a widow, Catherine A. Frey and the following heirs at law, Samuel Frey, Jonathan Frey Crook, James Frey, William Frey, Susan Stine and Adam Stine her husband, Newton Frey, Ellen Frey, John W. Frey, William Frey, Prudence Frey, Emory Frey, Catherine Frey, Fannie Frey, Sarah Frey, and the unknown heirs of Celia Frey, deceased.
 2. That at the time of said John Frey's decease he was indebted unto the Plaintiffs, - W. B. Wheeler Son, in the sum of Eighty-four dollars, and to sundry other creditors in various sums of money.
 3. That said Crook Frey, William Frey and the unknown heirs of Celia Frey are domiciliaries of the State of Maryland, the other defendants being residents of said State and adults over twenty one years of age.
- The Bill prays for a decree for the sale of said real estate and payment out of the proceeds of Plaintiffs claim, and such other creditors of John Frey deceased, as may come in and contribute to the expenses of these proceedings, and the balance of any, to be divided among the parties entitled according to their respective rights and for general relief.

It is therefore, this 24th day of August 1895, ordered and decreed by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity. &
