The Bill of Complaint, of William M. Bopst, of Frederick County, Maryland, who sues as well for himself as for all the other Creditors of Edward A. Brunner, late of Frederick County, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expense of this Suit respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That the said Edward A. Brunner was, in his lifetime and at the time of his death indebted unto your Complainant in the full and just sum of fifty seven dollars upon his promissory note bearing date November 17th, 1904 payable twelve months after date from November 17th, 1905 to February 17th, 1907, on one hundred and seven dollars the original face of the note, at which time fifty dollars was paid on said note and with interest on said sum of fifty seven dollars from February 17th, 1907, as will appear by reference to said promissory note filed herewith marked exhibit no. 1, together with all other exhibits herewith filed it is prayed may be taken and considered as part of this Bill of Complaint.

2. That on the 14th day of November 1904, the said Edward A. Brunner in a deed from Arthur B. Fogle and Laura V. Fogle, his wife assumed the payment of a promissory
