Your orators, Complaining Says:-
 1. That John Gladhill, late of Frederick County,
 Maryland, died in the year 1899, leaving
 a last will and Testament dated September
 1, in the year 1898, and which was duly adm-
 itted to Probate by the orphans Court for
 Frederick County, Maryland, and which is
 found recorded in Liber J. R. W. No. 2, folio
 500, one of the Records of Wills in the office
 of the Register of Wills for Frederick County,
 Maryland, a duly Certified Copy of which
 is herewith filed as a part hereof, marked
 "Exhibit A."

2. That in said will Matilda Gladhill is
 given authority to appoint whom she wishes to
 execute said Will after her death, if there be
 any of the property real or personal of the
 said John Gladhill, remaining after the death
 of said Matilda Gladhill, widow of John Gladhill
 died in May in the year 1908, leaving a last will
 and Testament a Certified Copy of which is herewith
 filed as part hereof marked "Exhibit B."

 said Testator Matilda Gladhill, appointed James
 W. Meyer to be the Substituted Executor to carry out
