II. That all the parties Plaintiff and Defendant, are residents of the State of Maryland, excepting Mary M. Daywalt, and Ernest M. Daywalt, her husband, who are residents of the State of Maryland excepting Mary M. Daywalt, and Ernest M. Daywalt her husband, who are residents of Richmond in the State of Virginia.

Therefore your orator pray:-

I. That your Honor will construe the said will of John Gladhill, deceased, and determine if your orator, the said James W. Meyer, Substituted Executor, be given a power of Sale therein authorizing him to sell the real estate of said John Gladhill, deceased, as described in said Exhibit C and D.

2. That if no such power of Sale be in said Substituted Executor the said real estate of said John Gladhill, deceased, may be sold by a Trustee to be appointed by the decree of your Honorable Court, the net proceeds arising thereon to be divided under the terms and provisions of the last will of John Gladhill, deceased.

3. And for such other and further relief to which your orator may be entitled and as to your Honor will seem to be just and equitable in the premises.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your orator the writ of Subpoena directed unto the said Defendants, John W. Humes, and Minnie C. Humes, his wife, Charles L. Humes and Mary Humes his wife, residents of Frederick County, Maryland, and an order of Publication directed unto Mary M. Daywalt, and Ernest M. Daywalt, her husband residents of Richmond in the State of Virginia, the above named Defendants, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein and answer the premises, and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
