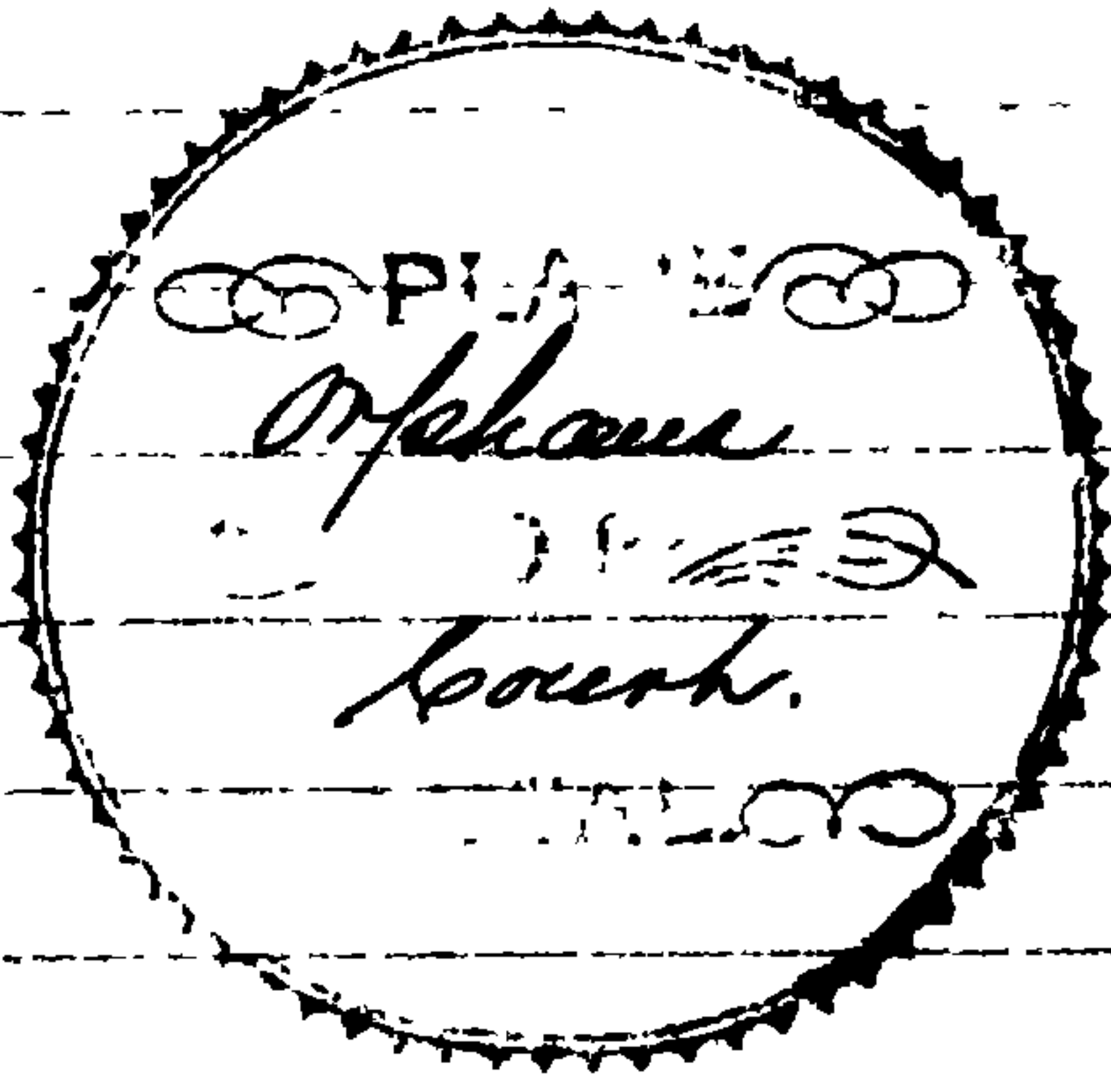

I Matilda Gladhill, widow of John Gladhill, and
resident of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, do
hereby make and publish this to be my last Will and
Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say:

After the payment of all my just debts and
funeral expenses, I hereby give and bequeath all of
my property and estate as follows:

I give and bequeath unto Matilda Grayson,
daughter of Mrs. Amanda C. Brewer of Frederick County,
Maryland, my Dress Cabinet and dishes, my duff
bag, and my large lamp, to be absolutely her own and
to be taken possession of by her immediately after my death.

I give and bequeath unto Amanda Matilda
Brewer, daughter of John S. Brewer, of Frederick County, Mary-
land, all my silver spoons, silver knives and silver forks

Whose under the terms of the last Will and
Testament of my husband, John Gladhill, deceased, as
found recorded in Liber J. N. N. 2, folios 500 and 501,
one of the record books of Wills in the office of the
Register of Wills for Frederick County, Maryland, said
Will being dated September 1st, in the year 1898.

The following power is given unto me, namely,
"I give my wife authority to appoint whom she wishes
to execute my will after her death, if there be
any of my property, real or personal, remaining."

Now, therefore, in the execution of said power and
authority, I, the said Matilda Gladhill, do hereby
nominate, constitute and appoint James H. Elyer,
resident of Sabillasville, in Frederick County, State
of Maryland, to be substituted, Executor to carry out
the provisions of the said last will and Testament of my
deceased husband John Gladhill after my death, according
to the true intents and purposes of said last will and
Testament.
