Money Rogers of Howard County in the State of Maryland are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in full and just sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars Current money, to be paid to the Said State of Maryland, or its certain attorney, to which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves and each of us, our, and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1896.

Whereas, by virtue of the power contained in a mortgage from James F. Thompson and wife dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1895 and recorded in lib. J. L. J. Lib. No. 10 Folio 791 &c., the said John G. Rogers is about to sell the property thereby mortgaged.

Now the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden John G. Rogers do and shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in him by said mortgage, or that may be reposed in him, and to abide by and fulfill any order or decree which shall be made by any Court of Equity in relation to the sale of such mortgaged property, or the proceeds thereof, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.
