This deed made this 29th day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty three by us John R. Nichols and Catherine Nichols his wife, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of the Sum of fifteen hundred and ninety eight dollars and Eighty one Cents we the said John R. Nichols and Catherine Nichols his wife, do grant unto Nicholas Baker of said County the following described real estate, Situated lying and being in the 5th, Election District in Frederick County Maryland, to-wit, first that tract of land containing forty acres of land more or less Situated along the Emmattsburg and Frederick Turnpike road about one half mile north of Mount Saint Marys College a survey of which containing the Corner and Distances was made by John Shields on the 19th day of April A. D. 1882, and a plat thereof as so Surveyed was filed as Exhibit No. 4, to the
