The Bill of Complaint of Josephus Stollmeyer
and Maud Stollmeyer his wife of Frederick County, State
of Maryland, respectfully, shew unto your Honors.

1. That Martin Van Buren Stollmeyer late of Said, Frederick
County, Maryland, deceased, was in his lifetime, and
at the time of his death seized and possessed in fee of
certain small tracts ^{or parcels} of land containing ten or seven -
sixteenths, acres, more or less, with improvements thereon, situated
lying and being in Section District in Said Frederick
County, and fully described in a deed for Said
land from Benjamin F. Fryor to Said Martin V. Stollmeyer
dated April 15th, A. D. 1901, and duly recorded among the
Land Records of Said Frederick County in Liber B. N. N. No.
17, fol. 596, a duly certified copy of which deed is filed
in this cause, marked "Exhibit B. F. F."
