 maintain me for love and affection, I the said
 Ann Sophia Tracey do grant unto George H. Tracey
 and Howard R. Tracey of the said County and
 State all the following described Lot or portion of
 ground situated in the County and State
 aforesaid and within the Corporate limits of
 Middletown and is part of a tract called
 "The Resurvey on Watsons Welfore". Beginning for
 said lot or portion of ground, to be conveyed in
