Upon the aforesaid petition and affidavit of
James H. Gambrell, Jr., Committee of Nettie G. Keller, it is
ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Circuit Court, sitting
as a Court of Equity, this 20th day of October, in the year
Nineteen Hundred and eight, that the Said James H.
Gambrell, Junior, Committee as aforesaid is hereby author-
ized and directed to release the dower of the Said
Nettie G. Keller in and to the undivided one half interest
of which Willard Keller died seized, in and to the property
described in Said Petition, and to sell and convey
unto The Mayor and Alderman of Frederick, a Municipal
Corporation of the State of Maryland, and for that purpose
to join Mary L. Marshall Trustee, in a deed of Said
Property to The Mayor and Alderman of Frederick, as
the purchaser thereof upon the receipt by Said Committee
from Said Purchaser the sum of Two Hundred and
