Therefore your prayer your Honor: I. That your Honor will pass the decree of your Honorable Court appointing a Trustee to sell the real estate of said Henry Eicholtz, deceased, as described in "Exhibit A" for the purpose of paying the promisory note due to your Orator, and other the unsuccessed Creditors of the said Henry Eicholtz deceased.

2. And for such other and further relief to which your Orator may be entitled, and as to your Honor will seem to be right and equitable in the premises.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Orator the writ of Subpoena of your Honorable Court, directed unto the said Adelmia J. Eicholtz, widow, and the said Esta Florence Eicholtz, Henry Baker Eicholtz, Sarah Katherine Eicholtz, Clara Belle Eicholtz, William Morris Eicholtz, and Helen Adelmia Eicholtz, infants, and the Frederick Town Savings Institution, Mortgagee, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day, to be named therein, and answer the premises and obey such Order or decree, as may be passed therein.
