That she admits the allegations contained in Paragraph six of Said Bill.

7.

That she admits the allegations contained in Paragraph seven of Said Bill.

That she admits the allegations contained in Paragraph eight of Said Bill.

And further answering Said Bill, this respondent says that she is a creditor of the estate of the Said Henry Eckelty, deceased, and that her claim consists of money that she advanced to pay the debts and liabilities of the Said Henry Eckelty, deceased, and which amounts to \$97.95 which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No Q, and prayed to be considered a cash fund; and also of money that she paid in maintaining the interest upon the mortgage indebtedness mentioned in Paragraph nine of the Bill of Complaint, in preserving the insurance upon Said property, and in furnishing money for the taxes upon Said property, which Said payments she has made continuously from the time of the Said Henry Eckelty's death.

Therefore, she the Said Adeline F. Eckelty, prays that, in the event your Honor should decree that the property, heretofore mentioned, be sold, and the relief prayed for in the Bill be granted, she respondent be allowed out of the proceeds of Said Sale her claims, as aforesaid, and be permitted to share in the fund as a creditor and have the same rights and privileges, in this behalf, to the same extent and as fully as if she had been made a creditor in the first instance.
