William M. Gaither a Witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined ~~depon~~ depone and say as follows:-

My name is William M. Gaither, I reside in Unionville Frederick County, Md. and I know all the parties to this suit. They are all children of Geo. W. and Harriet A. Belie. Rosa E. Belie, the Plaintiff is an adult now 21 years of age; and Laura Bohm one of the defendants, who is 16 a Widow is also an adult. The balance are all infants, and all the parties live in Frederick County, and all of them except Laura H. Bohm, at or near Mt. Airy.

I look at Exhibit No. 1, now shown me, and am acquainted with the property therein described, It is a part of the estate of George Belie late of Frederick County, deceased was the grand father of the parties to this Bill. After the death of said George Belie, the lands he owned were sold under a power of Attorney executed by his widow and heirs to Mrs. N.
