Hamilton Lindsey, a Witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff, being duly sworn and examined vis a vis, deposes and says as follows

My name is Hamilton Lindsey, I reside in Frederick City and know the parties to this cause I formerly resided in Unionville and am familiar with the neighborhood. The Parties are the children of George W. and Harriet A. Bline. Rosa Bline, the Plaintiff is an adult now 21 years of age and Laura Bline one of defendants, who is a widow is also an adult. The balance are all infants and all the parties live in Frederick County, and all except Laura A. Bline at or near Mt Airy.

I look at Exhibit No. 1, now shown me and am acquainted with the property therein described. It is a part of the estate of George Bline, late of Frederick County, deceased who was the Grand father of the parties to this Bill after the death of the said George Bline the lands he owned was sold under the power of Attorney executed by his widow and him to Wm. H. Warner in which power of Attorney it was stipulated and provided that one third of the purchase money, for the lands sold by him the remainder was to be payable by the purchaser thereof at the death of Sarah E. Bline, widow of said George Bline deceased.

The land described in Exhibit No. 1, was sold by said Warner attorney to Absolom Bline on that condition and said one third of the purchase money so charged thereon and remaining unpaid, became the said Sarah E. Bline is still living, was \$390.⁰⁰ after the death of said Absolom Bline said property was sold under a decree passed in No. 4889 Equity in this Court by Jasper Albright Trustee and assigned as set forth in said Exhibit No. 1. I look at Exhibit No. 2. The interest therein conveyed is the same that was owned to said Harriet A. Bline in Exhibit No. 1.

Said Harriet A. Bline is aged 51 years and the lands mentioned in Exhibit No. 1, is now owned
