

## No 6054 Equity.

Trustee's petition and  
Court's order referring  
matter to Auditor to  
State account.

Filed Dec. 8-1894

To the Honorable the Judges of Said Court,  
The trustee in the above entitled cause in your  
Honorable Court respectfully shows unto your Hon-  
ors that he has received from August W. Morse,  
purchaser of part of the land sold by him under  
the decree of your Honorable Court in this cause  
the sum of Four Hundred and forty nine  $\frac{9}{100}$   
dollars in full of the purchase money for said  
land and the interest on deferred payment there-  
for, also the sum of ten dollars for fruit of  
orchard, sold said money and sixteen dollars  
to pay said Peter Luperbell price for sale of  
land, also the sum of thirty nine  $\frac{9}{100}$  being  
balance of one hundred dollars for land sold  
to Laura A. Bohm on and above the share owing  
to her from proceeds of land sales, and for  
which share she is willing to execute her receipts  
and release to this Trustee.

2. That he is credibly informed that Walter A.  
Blaine one of the defendants in above case who  
was a minor at time of filing the Bill thereon has  
since reached the age of twenty one year and  
the trustee prays your Honors to pass an order  
referring the matter to the Auditor of your Honorable  
Court to state an account accordingly, distributing the  
trust fund and allowing the payments made by your  
petitioner as per Voucher filed &c. &c.
