2. That by said deed it was provided as to the real estate thereby conveyed that the said Trustee should suffer and permit the said Lewis H. Hill and Margaret E. Hill, his wife, and family as then constituted to use and occupy the dwelling house mentioned in said deed together with the household and kitchen furniture therein contained, for and during the lives of the said Lewis H. Hill and Margaret E. Hill and the life of the survivor of them, and to enjoy, use and receive the rents, issues and profits of the other real estate thereby conveyed during the lives of the said Lewis H. Hill and Margaret E. Hill, and the life of the survivor of them as they were enjoyed before the execution of said deed; and that from and immediately after the death of the survivor of the said Lewis H. Hill and Margaret E. Hill, his wife the said Trustee was to sell and dispose of the Real Estate thereby conveyed, remaining unsold at the death of the survivor of such life tenant, and then to divide the proceeds of the sale of said real Estate, and of the personal property among the children of the said Lewis H. Hill equally, share and share alike, with certain provisions in case any of such children should die before the period of distribution.

3. That said deed of trust also conveyed all notes, book accounts, sums of money and personal property belonging to the said Lewis H. Hill to said Trustee upon the trusts set forth in said deed, a report of which will be filed hereafter in this cause.

4. That your petitioner accepted said trust and on February 5th, 1890, filed his duly approved bond as such trustee in the office of the Clerk of your Honorable Court in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars.

5. That the Grantor Lewis H. Hill died in the month of February 1894, and his wife Margaret E. Hill, who was the survivor of said life tenants, died in the month of August 1908, and that your petitioner having applied the rents, issues, profits and income from said trust estate to the support and maintenance of said Grantor, and their family
