To The Honorable, the Judge of Said Court:-

The Bill of Complaint of Addie McComick,
and John McComick, her Husband of Frederick County,
State of Maryland, respectfully show unto your Honor:-

1. That Mary Jane Brown, late of Said Frederick County,
Maryland, deceased, was in her life time and at the
time of her death seized and possessed in fee Simple of
Certain real estate consisting of a House and lot of ground
on the east side of North Benty Street in Frederick City,
Frederick County, State of Maryland, and which is more fully
described in a deed from Sophia N. Schultz, executrix, et al,
to Mary M. Schultz (now Mary M. Kemp, wife of G. Thomas Kemp)
dated February 12th, 1889, and recorded among the Land Records
of Said ^{Frederick} County, in Liber N. S. T. No. 6, folio 735 r. and subsequently
conveyed from Said Mary M. Kemp and husband to Said Mary Jane
Brown by deed dated August 14th, 1890, and recorded among Said
Land Records in Liber N. S. T. No. 11 folio 443, a Certified Copy
of which last mentioned deed is herewith filed as part
hereof marked Exhibit No. 1.

2. That being so seized and possessed of the House
and lot of ground as aforesaid, Said Mary Jane Brown
departed this life intestate, on or before the 28th day of
March A. D. 1908, leaving surviving her a Husband, James
Wesley Brown, who resides in Frederick City, Maryland, and
whose age is about 64 years, and the following Children as
