- (3) A daughter, Alice Beall, whose husband's name is William Beall, both of whom are adults, residing at New Castle State of Pennsylvania;
- (4) a daughter, Mamie Locke, whose husband's name is Augustus Locke, both of whom are adults, residing in said Frederick County, Maryland;
- (5) a daughter, Virgie Slade, whose husband's name is Charles Slade, both of whom are adults, residing in Martinsburg, West Virginia;
- (6) a son, Charles Elmer Brown, who is an adult, unmarried and resides in said Frederick County, Maryland;
- (7) a son, Edgar Brown, who is an adult, unmarried, and resides in said Frederick County, Maryland;
- (8) a son, Frank Brown, who is an ^{adult} non-resident of the State of Maryland, and whose whereabouts is unknown to your orators.

3. That the aforesaid Children of said Mary Jane Brown, are the owners as tenants in common of the aforesaid real estate of which said Mary Jane died seized and possessed as aforesaid, subject to the dower interest of their father, said James Wesley Brown:-

4. That said real estate cannot be divided without great loss and injury to the parties interested therein, and that the only way a division of the respective interests can be made is by a sale of said house and lot and a division of the proceeds;

5. And your orators pray for the following relief:- That the aforesaid real estate may be deemed to be sold by your Honorable Court in order that the proceeds may be divided among the parties according to their respective interests, and that your orators may have such other and better relief as the nature of their case may require;

7. And your orators pray the following process:-

(1) That the writ of Subpoena may be directed to the said James Wesley Brown, surviving husband, Mamie Locke and Augustus Locke, her husband, Charles Elmer Brown, all adults residing in said Frederick County, Maryland; and William C. Kater and Lizzie Kater, his wife residing in the City of Baltimore, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some day certain to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein, and

(2), That an order of Publication be issued out of your Honorable Court, giving notice to the said Alice Beall and William Beall, her husband both adults non-residents of
