eration of the sum of Eighty five Dollars, we the said Mary  
Matilda Kemp and C. Thomas Kemp her Husband do grant  
and convey unto Mary Jane Brown, wife of James M. Brown  
that lot or parcel of ground situate, lying and being on  
the east side of Duty Street, between Birch and South  
Streets in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, and  
being the same property fully described in a deed from  
Sophia S. Shultz, Executrix, et al. to Mary M. Shultz,  
now Mary M. Kemp, wife of C. Thomas Kemp, of date February 17,  
1889, and duly recorded in Liber H. S. P. No. 6, folio 780 etc., one  
of the Land Books of Frederick County, Maryland, to have
