The object of this Suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the real estate of which Mary Jane Brown, late of Frederick County, Maryland, died seized and possessed.

The Bill in substance states that said Mary Jane Brown was at the time of her death seized and possessed of a house and lot on the east side of Wood Beuty Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, State of Maryland, which property is described in a deed from Sophia S. Shultz, executrix, et al. to Mary M. Shultz (now Mary M. Kemp, wife of C. Thomas Kemp), dated February 12, 1889, and by a subsequent deed from said Mary M. Kemp and husband to said Mary Jane Brown, a certified copy of of which last mentioned deed is filed as an exhibit to said Bill; that said Mary Jane Brown died intestate on or about the 30th day of March A. D. 1908, leaving a surviving husband, James Wesley Brown, and the following named children as her only heirs at law, viz:- a daughter, the Plaintiff, Addie M. McCormick whose husband's name is John McCormick both of whom are adults residing in said Frederick County, William C.
