to the Plaintiffs: That the aforesaid Children of Said Mary Jane Brown are the owners as tenants in common of the aforesaid Real Estate: that Said real estate is not susceptible of division among the parties interested therein without great loss and injury.

The Bill then prays that Said real estate may be decreed to be sold by the Court in order that the proceeds may be divided among the parties according to their respective rights and interests, and for general relief and for the writ of Subpoena against the residents, and an order of Publication against the non-residents defendants.

It is therefore this 28th day of July A. D. 1908, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, adjudged and ordered that the Plaintiffs, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Said Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 27th day of August A. D. 1908, give notice to the said Alice Baker, and William Beall, her husband, residents of the State of Pennsylvania; Virgie Alade and - Alade, her husband, residents of the State of West Virginia, and Frank Brown, a non-resident of the State of Maryland, and whose residence is unknown to Said Plaintiffs, of the object and substance of this Bill and warning them to be and appear in this Court on or before the 12th day of September A. D. 1908, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
