To the Honorable: the Judges of said Court

Mr. J. Henry Lewis, a witness of lawful age
 produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being first
 duly sworn deponee and says as follows:—

1st. State your name age & residence?—
 ans. My name is Josiah Henry Lewis, I am
 73 years of age & I reside in Frederick City, Maryland.
 2nd. Do you know the parties to this Cause
 and the property mentioned in these proceedings?
 ans. I know all the parties to these proceedings
 except William E. Plater, I know the property mentioned
 in these proceedings. I have been the Collector of the
 rent for the owner of adjoining property for a number
 of years.

3rd. Did you know Mary ^{June} Brown?
 Is she living or dead, if dead, when did she die?
 ans. I know her, she is dead, she died in
 the early spring of 1908.

4th. Did she die testate or intestate in Frederick County?
 ans. She left no will that I saw and of at the
 time of her decease, she was seized and possessed of
 a small house & lot of ground on Rock Bury Street
