Will of John Condon.

In the name of God Amen,
I John Condon of Tucker County, in the State of Maryland being in a weak State of body but of sound and disposing mind and Understanding Considering the Certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and to thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me home do therefore make and published this my last will and testament in manner & form following that is to say.

First and principally I Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor herein after named and after my debts and funeral charge are paid I devise & bequeath as follows:—

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betty Condon one cow, two sheep and two hogs her heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Condon one cow, two sheep and two hogs her heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my dear wife Catherine Condon all my estate real and personal during her life or widowhood except the bequeir above mentioned and after her death I will that all my estate real and personal to equally divided between my two Sons Zachariah Condon and Joseph Condon their heirs and assigns forever share and share alike.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Thomas C. H. Toole Executor of this my last will and testament making and annulling all former Wills by me heretofore made satisfying and Confirming this and none other by my last will and testament.
