To the end, therefore,

(1) That a decree may be passed for the Sale of the said real estate.

(2) That the proceeds of said Sale may be distributed among your Complainants and the said Defendants according to their respective rights and interests.

(3) That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as their case may require.

may it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena against the said Arthur Siedling and Mary V. Siedling, infant Defendants, both of Montgomery County, Maryland, requiring them to appear in this Court, on some certain day to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
