Maanoma E. Slixon, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being first duly sworn and examined Viva Voce depone and says as follows:-

My name is Maanoma E. Slixon. I am 42 years of age and I reside in Woodville District in Tucker County. I know the parties to this Suit and I know the Land described in the proceedings. I know the family of Mr. Thomas M. V. Norwood, and they have been correctly described by the preceding witnesses: whose testimony I have heard.

I know that the defendant Mary Love, who is about 14 years of age and who is the daughter of Rev. Willard F. Love, an itinerant Minister of the M. E. Church, Two thousand dollars in my opinion is a fair price for the place, and Mary Love, being in the care of her Father who moves from place to place. I think under the circumstances it would be to her benefit and advantage to have her interest sold along with the interest of the other Co-owner, and to have the Sale confirmed as to her interest in the farm. Her interest in the proceeds of Sale can be disposed of more to her advantage than if she retains her interest in the farm.

Norwood and I know his family to be as given by the preceding witnesses. I regard \$2000- as a fair price for the said farm and I think it would be to the benefit and advantage of the infant Mary Love to have her interest sold along with that of the other owner. I think the money could be used very much more to her advantage than allowing her interest to remain in the land, her father being a Minister is not in the neighborhood to look after her interests and she or her father would have to be compelled which would be to the disadvantage of all concerned.
