- 1 That in the first place he gave bond to the State of Maryland in the sum of Seven Hundred dollars, conditioned to the faithful performance of his duties, in accordance with the directions contained in said decree, which bond, with Surety thereon, was duly approved by the Clerk of your Honorable Court and by said Clerk filed among the records of his office.
- 2 That he then made Sale of the said interest of the said infant defendant to the said John T. Norwood, said interest being an undivided one-sixth interest which she held in common with the said John T. Norwood, he having previously purchased all the other interests in said real estate as set forth in the testimony in this cause; That the price agreed to be paid by the said purchaser for the entire interest of all the parties in interest, including the estate of the widow Margaret L. Norwood, is two thousand dollars, as shown by the testimony in this cause, wherefore the interest of the said infant defendant in the purchase money is one-sixth thereof, or three hundred and thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents. (\$333.33) Subject to the rights of the said Margaret L. Norwood therein.
3. That your said orator has not received in hand any part of the said purchase money, but that said purchaser has agreed to pay over the interest of the said Mary Lane upon the ratification of said Sale by your Honorable Court.
- 4 That the gross amount of Sale is the said sum of three hundred and thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents (\$333.33) wherefore your orator and Petitioner pray your Honors to pass an order ratifying the said Sale.
