That all the real estate described in Said Exhibit A and in Said Exhibit is held in Common, the undivided one-half part thereof by your oratrix Emily J. Lamar, the grantee named in Said Exhibit A; and the other undivided half part thereof by your oratrix, the Said Emily J. Lamar and Mary M. Johnson as joint tenants during their lives and of the survivor of them for her life, and in remainder unto your oratrix, Emily M. Johnson, Ann R. Jones, Cornelia Gray and the infant Defendant Vivian A. Lamar, the grantees named in Said Exhibit B; - all of which will appear by reference to Said Exhibit A and Said Exhibit B.

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That the real estate described in and conveyed by Said Exhibit A and Said Exhibit B cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested.

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That the money secured by the Mortgage Exhibit C and D is now due and payable by the terms and conditions of said Mortgage as will appear unto them. Therefore your orator prays your Honors for the following relief:

That your Honors will pass the decree of your Honorable Court directing that the lands and premises mentioned in these proceedings in Exhibit B, be sold by a Trustee or Trustees, named in Said decree.

That your Honors will pass the decree of your Honorable Court, directing that a part of the lands and premises mentioned in these proceedings, and being the same as described in Exhibit C, and in Exhibit D, be sold by a Trustee or Trustees named in Said decree.

That Said lands and the interests therein of all the parties to this Bill of Complaint shall be sold free and clear of two mortgages Exhibit E and Exhibit F, and that the rights of the lienors, the Said Arthur Potts Assignee of Mortgage, and the Said Charles P. Long, Trustee, in No. 4887, Equity, Assignee of Mortgage, shall be protected in the distribution of the proceeds of the sale of the lands mentioned in Said Bill of Complaint.

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That your Honors will direct the net proceeds arising from the sale of one undivided one-half part thereof be paid unto your oratrix, Emily J. Lamar, the grantee named in Said Exhibit A.
