

No. 8369. Equity.

This Deed made this twenty fourth day of October in the year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy four by William Johnson of Robert and Elizabeth de Johnson his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland.

Witnesseth, that in Consideration of the Sum of Thirteen Hundred and Sixty Seven Dollars and twenty five Cents the said William Johnson of Robert and Elizabeth de Johnson his wife do grant unto Baker J. Loman and F. T. L. Johnson of the said County and State of Maryland in fee simple the following piece or parcel of land: being part of a tract of land called "This is the way", it being part of the same land that was deeded to the said William Johnson by William M. Bell in 1838.

Beginning for the outline of the piece now being conveyed at a stone standing at the end of the lot line of "This is the way", and running thence with the 7th line N. 79° W. 139. 4/10 pps to a stake there with new lines made N. 31 3/4° W. 1 pps to the center of the County Road then S. 58 1/2° W. 8/10 pps S. 45° E. 1 1/10 pps S. 76 1/2° E. 4 73/100 pps S. 27° E. 143 2/100 pps to intersect the lot line of "This is the way", and with said line N. 32° E. 114. 88/100 pps to the beginning containing 45 ac 2 r 12. 1/2 of land more or less
