To the end, therefore:-

1st. That Said real estate heretofore described Compts of Smaer property located at various places which Complainant is compelled to rent to divers parties for such sums of money as she is able to realize there from. And Complainant the life tenant being alone in the world, is unable to give to Said property the necessary attention to make the same profitable nor is she able to look after the same and keep it in proper condition and repair.

And Complainant believes and so charges that it would be highly beneficial to him as well as the infant remaindermen, to sell all of the Said real estate and invest the proceeds in some safe mortgage or other security, which would produce a certain and regular income for the benefit of Complainant and infant children.

5th. That Said real estate is constantly depreciating in value, in the hands of tenants without any suitable or competent person to manage the same.

And petitioner believes that it would be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties of interest that Said real estate be sold under the decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds of sale invested in safe securities of some character.

6th. That there is no other person interested in Said estate under the terms of Said exhibit No. 1. except Complainant Mary E. Norman, Adult and the Said Mary E. Norman and Ruth M. Norman, infant defendants, in this cause.

To the end, therefore:-

1st. That Said real estate mentioned in the foregoing Bill of Complaint be sold under the decree of your Honorable Court, and the proceeds arising from Said Sales be distributed by your Honorable Court under the provisions of Said Will Exhibit No. 1.

2nd. - And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

May it Please Your Honor to Grant unto Complainant the writ of Subpoena directed to the Said Mary E. Norman and Ruth M. Norman, infant defendants, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named in Said writ abide by and perform such decree as may be passed
