

No. 8219. Equity.

Alice W. Hayden has executed an agreement to convey unto a Certain behaver T. N. Young, of Frederick, Maryland, the house and lot above described, at and for the sum of Thirty two hundred and Sixty dollars, and that the said Alice W. Hayden approves of said sale and has also executed said agreement which is filed herewith and marked exhibit "Contract".

Sheweth

That it is to the interest and advantage of all the parties in interest that said sale should be confirmed by your Honorable Court under the provisions of Section 213. of Article 16. of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, and that some suitable person should be appointed by your Honorable Court, for the purpose of conveying said real estate in accordance with the agreement heretofore mentioned.
