This is the Last will and testament of
 me Elijah Thomas of Frederick County, in the State
 of Maryland. I give and devise unto James McSherry
 of said County, and State, my house and lot in
 which I now reside situated in Frederick City, in
 said County, of Frederick in the said State of
 Maryland adjoining the residence of McIntock
 Young on the north and adjoining the premises
 occupied by Colonel D. V. Bluglander on the south
 to have and to hold said house and lot to him,
 the said James McSherry and his heirs in trust
 nevertheless for the following purposes viz. to suffer
 and permit Alice W. Hayden wife of John W.
 Hayden to use, occupy and live in the said
 house and lot and to receive and to take unto
 herself for her own sole and separate use or her
 separate estate all the rents, issues and profits and
 income that may arise therefrom during the life of
 the said Alice W. Hayden; and upon the death
 of the said Alice W. Hayden then in further trust
 to convey said house and lot unto the Children
 of said Alice W. Hayden in fee simple.

I give and bequeath unto the said Alice
 W. Hayden all the furniture, household and kitchen
 glass, and other wares that may be had in said house
 and on said premises at the time of my decease
 except such as I may in my lifetime otherwise donate.

I give and bequeath unto said James McSherry
 the sum of One thousand dollars.

I give unto, and bequeath unto Mr. Edward

 County, the sum of one thousand dollars.
