

NO. 8279. Equity.

Said house and lot unto James McSherry, and his heirs, in trust nevertheless, for the following purposes, viz. - To suffer and permit Alice M. Kaydon, wife of John A. Kaydon, to use, occupy, and live in said house and lot, and to receive and to take unto herself for her own sole and separate use, and as her separate, all the rents, issues and profits and income that may arise therefrom during the life of the said Alice M. Kaydon, and upon the death of the said Alice M. Kaydon, then in full trust, to convey said house and lot unto the children of the said Alice M. Kaydon, in fee simple."

Second.

That on the 24th day of October, A.D., 1907, the said Testamentary trustee, died, and that upon the death of the said James McSherry, Testamentary Trustee, as aforesaid, the vested legal title to the fee in remainder to the estate and property mentioned after the life estate of the said Alice M. Kaydon, descended to and vested in his eldest son J. Roger McSherry under article 46, Section 24, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland and that his the said J. Roger McSherry's duty under said will is or will be to convey the said property to the children of the said property to the children of the said Alice M. Kaydon after her death.

Third.

That the said J. Roger McSherry has removed from the state of Maryland, and is now resident of the state of Illinois; and that the said J. Roger McSherry has resigned as said trustee, and requested the appointment of William T. Kaydon, as trustee, in his stead and said William T. Kaydon has been duly appointed such trustee in No. 8277, Equity.

Fourth.

That the said Alice M. Kaydon has five children, all of whom are above the age twenty one years, and their names and residences are as follows:

William T. Kaydon John J. Kaydon and Alice M. Hall, (who live with her husband, J. Bernard Hall,) all residents of Baltimore City, Maryland; Gustave H. Kaydon, who resides with her husband, Homer S. Williams in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and Charles J. Kaydon, who resides with his wife, Ethel Marie Kaydon in New York City, New York State.
