

The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted Bill Answer Exhibits and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is therefore, this 3^d day of September in the year Nineteen Hundred and eight by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Alexander Mill of — County, be, and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows: He shall first file in the office of the Clerk of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed by him with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Sixteen hundred dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this decree or which may be reposed in him by any future order, or decree in the premises. He shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notices as he may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale; which terms shall be as follows: one third of the purchase money to be paid in cash on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in two equal payments of one and two years from the day of sale, the purchaser or purchasers giving his or their notes with approved security, and bearing interest from the day of sale or all cash, at the option of the purchaser, and
