(2) Annie Hughes, wife of John Hughes, Maggie Joseph, wife of Robert Joseph, and Hugh Hughes Child, son of Ellen Morgan, a deceased sister of the said Ann Williams.

3. Jane Garraus, wife of Charles Garraus, a sister of the said Ann Williams.

4. That at the time of his death the said William Williams was indebted unto your matrix upon an open account for money loaned and services rendered to the aggregate amount of thirty one hundred and five dollars, which said account duly protated is herewith filed marked "Exhibit No. 6" and the whole amount whereof is still due and unpaid.

5. That the personal estate of the said William Williams, deceased, is largely insufficient to pay the said debt due your matrix, and other just claims of sundry creditors of said decedent, and a sale of the aforesaid real estate, under a decree of your Honorable Court, will be necessary in order that the proceeds thereof may be applied to the payment of the said claims of your matrix and other creditors.

(6) That a certain Cassidy Litchman has been appointed by the Orphan Court, of Frederick County, and duly qualified, as Administrator of the goods and chattels of the said Williams, deceased, as will appear by an Exemplification of his letters of Administration herewith filed marked, Exhibit No. 7.

(7) That the said William Williams and Ann Williams, his wife, executed a mortgage upon the first five tracts or parts of tracts of land hereinbefore mentioned to the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick a body Corporate, to secure a loan of \$870., said mortgage being dated October 19th, 1898, and recorded in Liber No. 4, folio 300 - one of said Land Records, and a certified copy whereof is herewith filed marked "Exhibit No. 8."

8. That on the 25th day of March 1901, a certain William A. Smith, returned in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, a judgment against the said William Williams and Ann Williams, for the sum of \$263.17, said judgment being No. 95, Trials February Term 1901, on the docket of said Court, and a certified transcript whereof is herewith marked "Exhibit No. 9."
