At the request of William Williams the following deed is recorded Dec. 26th 1887.

This deed made this twentieth day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy five by John H. Wolfe & Lavinia Wolfe his wife of Frederick County, and Jane Hoyatt and Ann L. Hoyatt his wife Theodor S. Beuton and Mary H. Beuton his wife, Kate H. Wolfe and Jesse H. Wolfe of Montgomery County, All of State of Maryland, Witness:- that in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty dollars lawful money in hand paid the said John H. Wolfe and Lavinia Wolfe his wife Jane Hoyatt, and Ann L. Hoyatt, his wife, Theodor S. Beuton and Mary H. Beuton his wife, Kate H. Wolfe and Jesse H. Wolfe do grant unto William Williams of Frederick County, state of Maryland, his heirs and assigns in fee simple all that piece or parcel of land lying in Frederick County, and state aforesaid, and described as follows, Beginning at the end of the second line of that tract of land called the "Labyrinth" reserved for Phillip Hammond Hopkins on or about the 11th day of August 1787, and running then with said land four courses, West twenty feet, N. 76 West. 36. ps. N. 54 West, 30 ps. N. 10. E. 5. ps. and an half feet, to intersect the 20th line of that tract of land, Called the Principal granted to Mathias Bondy on or about the 25th day of January 1747, then by and with said line four following courses S. 50. E. 26. ps. N. 76. E. 36. ps. E. 70. ps. S. 36. E. 133. ps. then S. 82. N. 1 ps. to intersect the aforesaid second line of the Labyrinth, then by a straight line to the first beginning containing six and three quarters of an acre of land according to the Certificate of the
