 notwithstanding.

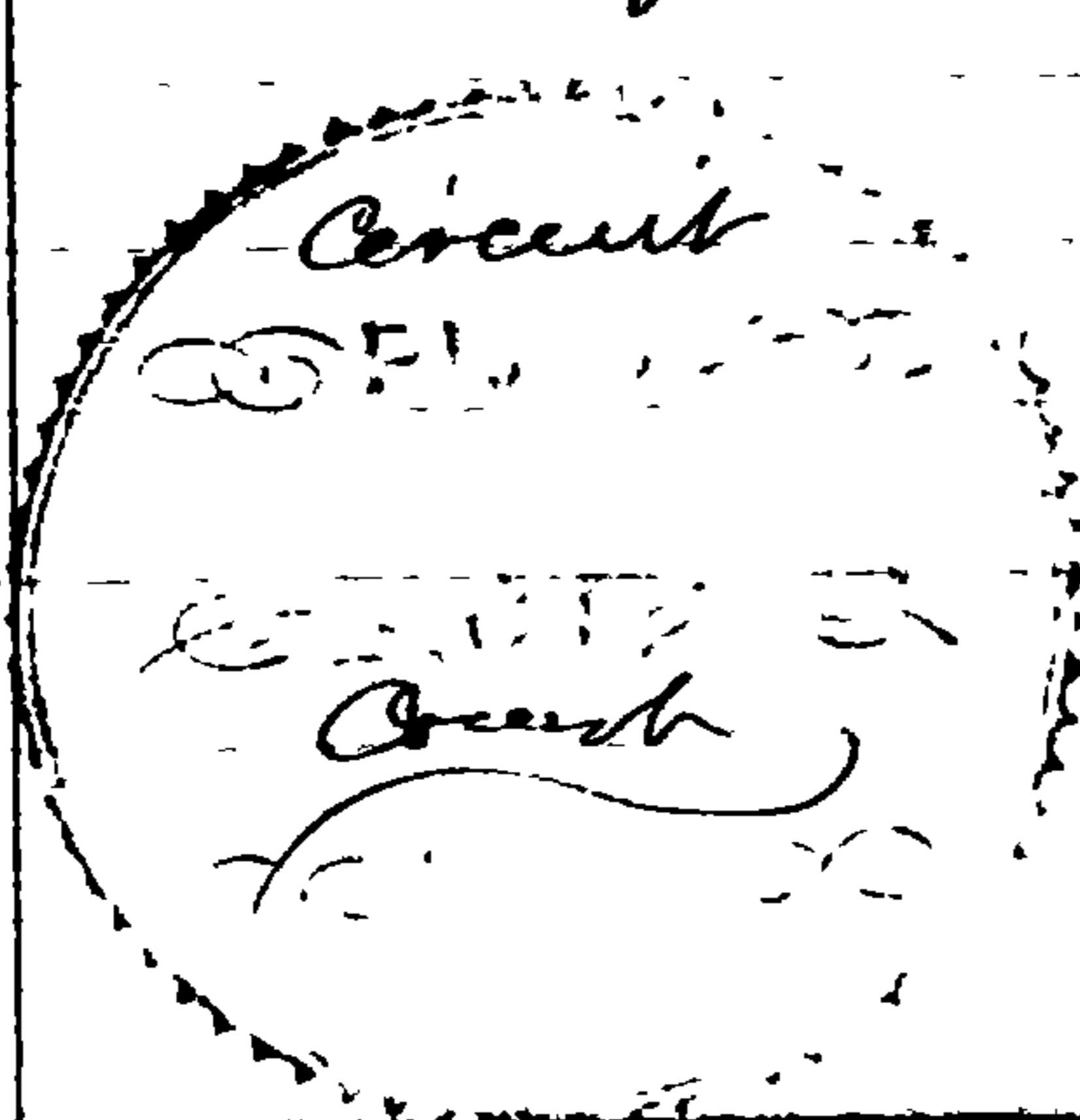
