William H. Ogle & Cordelia Ann Ogle his wife, do grant in fee simple to Ebenezer Hoyt, of the County and State aforesaid, all the following described parcel of land, situate and being in the County, and State aforesaid, and being an outline survey of the two parcels of land found in a deed from Eli Neumann to William H. Ogle by deed bearing date March 22nd, A. D., 1884, and recorded in Liber N. F. No. 9, folio 45, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Beginning for the said better survey so as to include the same in one parcel, at the beginning stone of the first parcel, at the beginning stone of the first parcel named in the aforesaid deed which beginning stone the end of 75 1/2 perches on the south line of a tract of land of Adam Shillitoe allowing for variation to compound with stone formerly planted north 20° East 18 7/10 perches to a stone at the South west corner of Barbara Graville's Lot, then with South line of said Lot, South 69 1/2° East, 18 perches to the end thereof, to a stone, South 37 1/2° W. 19 9/10 perches, South 68 3/4° East, 32 perches to a spring on the Fogles' line where Samuel Phipps land now corners, then with said Phipps land South 28° West, 15 7/10 per. to a Hickory tree, again with said Phipps land, North 68 1/4° West 42 1/2 perches to a high rock in which a hole is drilled for a corner North 20° East, with a straight line to the beginning, containing 4 acres 3 rods and 30 sq. perches of land, more or less.

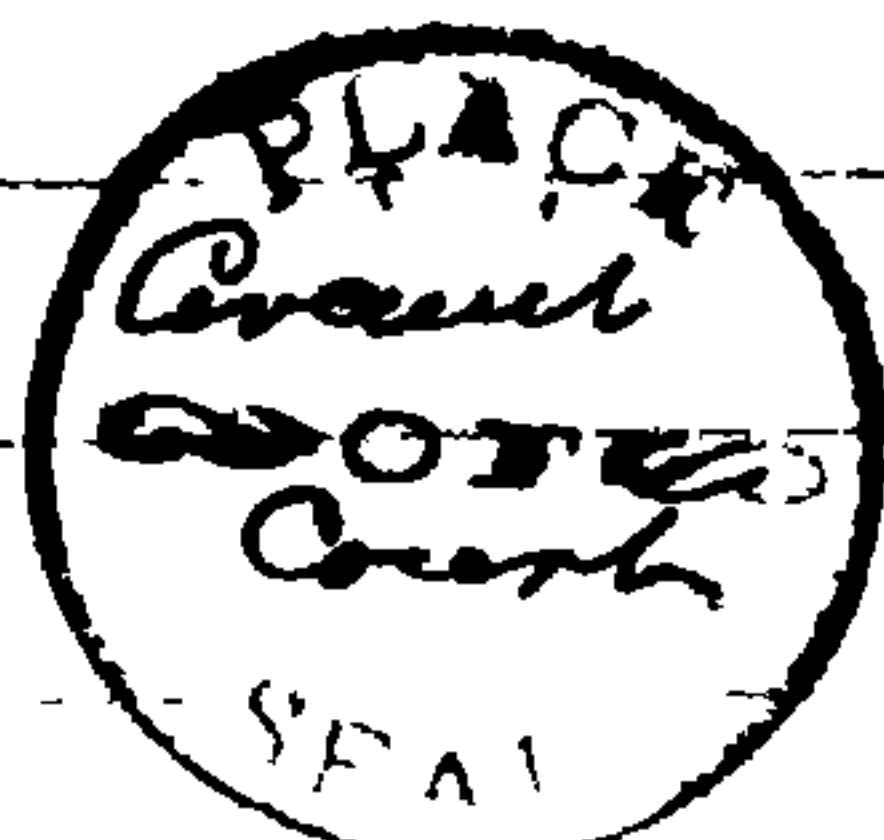
