the amount of the distributive share of the said William H. Biggs in said estate he was indebted to the estate in the sum of eight thousand eight hundred and ninety three dollars (\$8893.00) which the sum of money, along with interest thereon from the tenth day of October 1906, is a lien upon the one-fourth interest in the land acquired by the said Phoebe S. Biggs under a deed from Robert Biggs trustee as stated in the third paragraph of this Bill of Complaint.

VII.

That William H. Biggs is married and his wife is named Annabelle Biggs.

VIII.

That the said William H. Biggs and Annabelle Biggs, his wife, have had the following children, viz: Joshua Edgar Biggs, Thomas Bruce Biggs, Sarah May Biggs, Phoebe J. Biggs, James Morris Biggs, Robert Clay Biggs, Beulah McDonald Biggs, and Annabelle Ruth Biggs all of whom are living but the said Phoebe J. Biggs, James Morris Biggs, Robert Clay Biggs, Beulah McDonald Biggs and Annabelle Ruth Biggs are infants under twenty-one years of age, the said Thomas Bruce Biggs being a non-resident of the State of Maryland but his present residence being unknown to your orator.

IX.

That the said Sarah May Biggs is married and her husband's name is John A. Robertson.

X.

That Robert Biggs is married and his wife's name is Alice C. Biggs.

XI.

That James S. Biggs married, and died intestate in August, 1907, leaving surviving him his widow Sophia C. Biggs and the following children, Mildred H. Biggs, Skindan C. Biggs and Richard H. Biggs, all of whom are infants under twenty-one years of age, as his heirs at law.

XII.

That the said David M. Biggs married, and died intestate in August 1907, leaving surviving him his widow Emma S. Biggs, and one child, Dorothy C. Biggs, an infant under twenty-one years of age, as his heirs at law.

XIII.

That in addition to the real estate heretofore referred to, your orator, Robert Biggs, and his brother, James S. Biggs, were seized and possessed, as tenants in common, of a lot of ground, situate at Rocky Ridge in the State of Maryland; being the same lot of ground which was granted and conveyed to them by Phoebe S. Biggs by deed dated the ninth day of February, 1903, and duly recorded in Liber A. N. N. No. 15, folio 626 &c., one of Land Records
