

This deed made this 9th day of February in the  
year one thousand nine hundred and three, by Phoebe  
S. Biggs of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland.  
Witness that in consideration of one dollar the said Phoebe  
S. Biggs doth hereby grant and convey unto James S. Biggs  
and Robert Biggs all of that lot of ground, situated,  
lying and being in Frederick County, in the State  
of Maryland, and fully and particular described  
as follows: Beginning for the same in the same  
in the middle of the old Neagstown road at a point  
near a Culmsh, and running thence South Seventy five  
degrees West thirteen and three tenths perches to the  
place of beginning, containing two rods and thirty  
three square perches.

Being the same lot of ground which was  
conveyed to William H. Biggs by Joshua Biggs, by deed  
dated the 2nd day of April, 1888, and duly recorded  
in Liber N. S. T. No. 6, fol. 136, one of the land records  
of Frederick County. For title of Grantor see deed  
from Robert Biggs, trustee to Phoebe S. Biggs, N. S. T.
