Whitmore, the present pastor of the German Reform Congregation of Christians at Rocky Ridge or to whom here may from time to time, be the pastor of the said Congregation, to be used by the Pastors of the said Congregation, towards defraying the expenses of maintaining the said Congregation at Rocky Ridge.

Should it be determined, at any time, by the Consistory of said Congregation to erect a new Church at Rocky Ridge or to buy the Church in which said Congregation now worships, then in that case, I direct the said trustee to pay to the Reverend George N. Whitmore, or to whomsoever may be the then pastor of the said Congregation, the said fund of Five Hundred dollars, paid from the trust, to be used towards defraying the cost of erecting the new Church or buying the Church in which the Congregation now worships.

And I further direct that the receipts of the Reverend George N. Whitmore or whomsoever may from time to time, be the pastor of the said Congregation, shall be a full acquittance and satisfaction to said trustee for the said interest and for said fund thereof, if it should at any time be paid over in the manner hereinbefore provided.

Fifth: After providing the fund for the legacy in favor of Church hereinbefore mentioned, I direct my executor hereinafter named, to ascertain the exact value of the residue of my estate, real and personal; for this purpose, he shall include therein the interest in land acquired by me under the proceedings in the Cause of Thelma S. Biggs vs William H. Biggs (No. 6980 Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity), valuing the same at seven thousand five hundred and ten dollars, and shall inventory at their fair value each and every note, demand and claim which I may hold at the time of my death against my Sons, William H. Biggs, Robert Biggs, James S. Biggs and David M. Biggs, respectively, adding interest on each claim, to the date of valuation as aforesaid, and to divide the same into four equal parts, that is to say one part for each of my Sons.

In making said division my executor shall include in the part intended for William H. Biggs all of the notes, claims and demands, due by him to my estate, with interest as aforesaid also the interest in the land acquired by me as aforesaid at the value of seven thousand
