At the request of Ann Rebecca Stroger the following deed was recorded March 7th 1859.

This deed made this 4th day of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty nine by Jacob Shank Sr. of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland; Witness, that in consideration of one hundred and twenty five dollars and twenty five cents, the said Jacob Shank Sr. doth grant unto Ann Rebecca Stroger, her heirs and assigns of the County and State aforesaid, all the following part of a tract of land, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid the same being part of a vacancy granted unto a certain John Shank on the 9th day of December 1877, and the aforesaid vacancy is included by the bounds and metes of the Patent of the aforesaid John Shank granted for 130. acres and called Shank's Troubles Enchid. Beginning for the outlines of the park hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone standing at the beginning of the 10th. line of the aforesaid patent the same being a corner of Nicholas Luedy's land, and thence running with said 10th line and the land of said Luedy along a line S. 22 1/2° E. 29 perches to a stone standing in the Public Road, thence with said road, S. 74° E. 9 1/2
