who is married and the name of whose wife is unknown to Complainants, adults, and non-residents of the State of Maryland and a daughter now the wife of Peter Welton who are adults and non-residents of the State of Maryland, and that said real estate is not susceptible of division without loss or injury to the parties interested, and ought to be sold under the proceedings in this Cause to save costs and expenses and to avoid a multiplicity of suits.

The Bill then prays for a decree for the sale of all said real estate, and a division of the money arising from such sale, among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective rights, and that said mortgage may be paid out of the proceeds of sale of the mortgaged property, and for general relief, and for process. It is therefore ordered this tenth day of September A. D. 1895, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity and by the authority thereof that the Complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted once a week in each of four successive weeks prior to the twelfth day of October A. D. 1895, in some newspaper published in Frederick County, give notice to Charles F. Shroyer and — Shroyer his wife John Thomas Shroyer and — Shroyer — his wife, and Rebecca Helman and Peter Helman her husband, the Adult non-resident defendants in this Cause of the substance and object of the bill filed in this Cause and warn them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the twenty-ninth day of October A. D. 1895, to show Cause if any they have why the relief prayed should not be granted.
