Shroyer died in January 1893 and left no will
 He left as his heirs at law the same persons
 above named as the heirs at law of his wife;
 they being also his children; and also two
 children and also two children by a former
 marriage viz:-

1. a Son John Thomas Shroyer who is married
 and whose wife's name is unknown and
 who are non-residents of the State of Maryland.
 I don't know their residence.

2. A daughter Rebecca now the wife of
 Peter Halseum, both of whom are non-residents
 of Maryland residing in Indiana. These last
 named children are also adults.

I know the real estate of which John Shroyer
 died seized and possessed. It is in Frederick
 County described in Exhibit No. 5, now shown
 me. It is about 22 acres and is worth about
 \$800 per acre. It is not susceptible of division
 among the heirs at law of John Shroyer without
 loss and injury to the parties. It would greatly
 save costs to have it sold under the decree
 in this case.
