To the Honorable, the Judge of Said Court:
Your Oratrix, who files this Bill as well for herself as for
all other Creditors of Lewis M. Niddoff, deceased, who may come in
and contribute to the expense of this suit, Complaining says:-

1. That Lewis M. Niddoff, late of Frederick County, was in
his lifetime indebted to your oratrix in the sum of Six
Thousand Dollars (\$6000), for which he and his wife, Eliza J. Niddoff
executed a joint and several promissory note, dated August 26,
1904, and payable five years after date to the order of your
Oratrix, with interest at the rate of five per cent, per annum
payable annually, as will appear by the original of said
note herewith filed, together with the Certificate of the Judge
thereof in the Orphan's Court of Frederick County, and prayed
to be taken as part hereof, marked "Exhibit, No. 1" and
the interest on said note was due and owing to your
Oratrix from the said Lewis M. Niddoff in his lifetime,
and at the time of his death from August 26, 1905, and the
whole of the principal of said note, and the interest from
said date remain unpaid; and the said Lewis M. Niddoff was
also in his lifetime, and is still indebted to your Oratrix in
the sum of money the amounts whereof have not yet been
ascertained on account of funds of your Oratrix in the
hands of said Lewis M. Niddoff as her agent and attorney
in fact.

2. That the said Lewis M. Niddoff being so indebted, died
on or about the 9th day of March A. D. 1908, leaving
a last will and testament whereby he devised and
bequeathed all of his property, and estate of every kind
and description to his wife, the said Eliza J. Niddoff
a Certified Copy of which said will is herewith filed
and prayed to be taken as part hereof, marked "Exhibit
No. 2."

3. That the said will appointed as the Executrix
thereof the said Eliza J. Niddoff, to whom letters
testamentary herewith have been granted, by the
Orphan's Court, of Frederick County, and the said
